Conference/Competitions organized

National Conference on Applications of Electronic and Computer Science

Electronics and Computer Science Department of the college organized Two Days National level Conference on '*Applications of Electronics and Computer Science*' on 20th and 21st January 2017. The Chief Guest for the inauguration was **Mr. Vivek Sawant**, Managing



Director and CEO, MKCL, Pune. He talked on the topic, '*Partnership of Human Intelligence and Non-Human like Intelligence*'. He focused on new opportunities and careers created due to the developments in advanced technologies. Further he talked about artificial intelligence, self correcting and self improving processes.

Mrs. Malati Kalmadi, Secretary, Kannada Sangha chaired the inauguration function. She appreciated and congratulated the organizers for good response for the conference. She explained the importance of research in higher education. The proceeding of the Conference was unveiled by Mrs. Malati Kalmadi, Secretary Kannada Sangha and the dignitaries on the dais.

Dr. Aditya Abhaykar, Dean, Faculty of Technology, SPPU was the resource person of the first technical session. He talked on the topic '*Towards Kernel Development in Machine Learning*'. He explained the (in) detail about the global trends in machine learning and latest trend of developing 'kernels'. Further he explained what is kernel, what makes it adaptive and how it is capable of solving interesting real life problems with engineered solution.

Dr. A.D. Shaligram, Professor and the Head of Department of Electronic Science, SPPU talked on the topic '*Smart Lifestyle with Evolving IoT Applications*'. He talked about the rapid development of electronic materials, devices and software tools in recent times which has resulted in explosion of applications of Internet of Things (IoT) at affordable prices. Further he explained the Sustainable, Mobility-driven, Accessible, Reconfigurable and Time-conforming (SMART) technology which has empowered human lifestyle.

Dr. Manasi S. Patwardhan, Associate Professor, VIT, Pune talked on the topic '*Human Behavioral Analytics*'. She focused on human behavior and observable emotions associated with individuals. She explained many real-life problems which can be solved by understanding, interpreting and further modeling how an individual's behavior gets projected in terms of their expressions, gestures, emotions, writings, etc, or perceived in terms of observations, feelings, sound stimuli, etc. She further explained the use of a variety of data to model projected human behavior to address a plethora of real-life problems using data mining and machine learning techniques.

➤ **Special Guidance Scheme**

Lecture by Dr. Vaishali Naik, Vice Principal, Arts and HoD, English Department of Baburaoji Gholap College, Pune was organized by Department of English for FYBA students on Wednesday, 11th January 2017 at 10 a.m. on the topic 'Short Stories: A Popular Genre in English Literature' under special guidance scheme. The purpose of this lecture was to make the students understand various aspects and importance of Short Story as a popular genre in English Literature. She initiated the lecture by talking about various short stories that were known to students. She gave various examples and illustrations of popular short stories from ancient history and recent literature.

Department of Economics

➤ A session 'Scope in the field of Economics' was conducted by Ms. Shweta Bhagat, for F.Y.B.A students on 18th February 2017. The objectives behind the session were to give detailed information in the field of economics and to make them aware about opportunities in the same. The session helped students in decision making while opting for specialization in second year. 25 students benefited from the session.

➤ The sessions on 'Union Budget Discussion' were conducted by Ms. Shweta Bhagat, for F.Y.B.A students on 18th February 2017 and 20th February 2017. Annual or Union 'Budget' was the topic for discussion. It is very important for students of Economics to understand the framework and basic concepts of Budget and therefore the sessions were conducted.

This Discussion was divided into two sessions:

1. Pre-Budget Discussion: The Pre-Budget Discussion took place on 18th February, 2017 where the discussion about meaning and concept of budget, how budget is prepared? What are the steps to prepare budget? When work starts? Who works in budget preparation? Who takes responsibilities in Budget? Who passes the budget? And who presents it? etc was covered.
2. Post Budget Discussion: This session took place on 20th February 2017. The discussion was on current budget. Approximately 25 students attended this session. This helped students to understand Budget in better way and how Economics is applied in real life.

Add-On Courses

The Department of Commerce in joint venture with Shraddha Infotech (Tally No.1 Company in Pune) have introduced 90 hours (3 months) course on TALLY ERP-9 in the year 2014-15. Achievements:

- i) Ground Levelling and maintenance:
 - a) The NSS volunteers cleaned the entrance of the village and the Gram Panchayat. With the help of a dumper more soil was unloaded and then the volunteers manually levelled the soil. They also looked after the trees planted in this area and watered them.
 - b) Maintenance work at Gram Panchayat Tekdi: The NSS volunteers made pits and watered 50 plants which were planted on Gram Panchayat tekadi.
- ii) Survey:
 - 1) As per the directions given by SPPU for conducting base line health survey, the NSS volunteers conducted a census survey at Kasaramboli.
 - 2) As a review of previous year's work, NSS Volunteers also conducted sample survey at Kasaamboli, Mankar wadi, Sutar wadi and Shinde wadi. Research Projects Exhibition:



The exhibition of the research projects under Kaveri Research and Innovation centre was organized on 7th January 2017. The exhibition was inaugurated at the hands of Mrs. Malati Kalmadi, Secretary, Kannada Sangha. Mr. B.B. Rao, Treasurer, Kannada Sangha, graced the occasion and congratulated all the participants. The list of projects and their topics are as follows:

From B Com total 4 teams participated in the research project exhibition as:

1. Rucha Joshi, SYB.Com div A, presented her research work on the topic '*Waste Management*'. Her research work was based on Case Study of Green Pharmacy on waste management.
2. Gayatri Tambekar and Jai Mithare, SYB.Com div A, presented their research work on the topic '*Water Pollution*'. Their research work was based on a case study of Khadakwasala Lake and Manas Lake. They compared the pollution level of water of both the lakes. They observed that Manas Lake is more polluted than Khadakwasala Lake.

3. Tejas Dharkar, TYB.Com div A, presented research work on the topic '*Dr. Ambedkar: An Economist*'. The research was based on secondary resources and it focused on economic thoughts, theories and beliefs of Dr. Ambedkar. It mainly focused on Dr. Ambedkar's principles and theories related to Agriculture, Industrial and Social reforms.
4. Akshaya Patil and Nikhil Khombete, F.Y. B Com A, presented a review on the topic '*Social Entrepreneurship*' with reference to NAAM Foundation.

1. They studied impact of demonetization on small vendors and concluded that small vendors are affected the most.
